Abstract from the Constitution

- a) Membership will be open to anyone over the age of 17 years who can demonstrate a genuine interest in the Objectives of the Group and who is willing to actively participate in its activities as scheduled and supervised by the Committee and its Appointees. (Not fully applicable to Associate membership)
- b) Any person wishing to become a Member must complete an application form that shall be submitted to the Secretary for retention of details.
- c) A candidate for membership will not be considered a member until the Treasurer has received the appropriate subscription and their application has been accepted at a suitable Committee meeting.
- d) The Committee may, at its discretion, refuse to admit any person to membership. Refusal shall be deemed appropriate if this view is upheld by a clear majority of Committee Members. No reason for refusal shall be deemed necessary
- e) Membership will be limited to five groups:- Ordinary, Family, Country, Associate and Institution.
